

Special Enrollment Period for Graduates & Others

You could enroll in health insurance right now!

Open Enrollment for 2019 coverage is over. See if you qualify for a Special Enrollment Period.



If you are graduating, turning 26, or leaving a school sponsored plan you could be eligible.

To determine coverage, follow these simple steps:

- 1 Create an account by going to HealthCare.gov, the Health Insurance Marketplace
- 2 Collect information like your pay stubs and W-2s
- 3 Apply for coverage by going to HealthCare.gov and selecting "get coverage"
- 4 Select a plan by comparing the various benefits, network providers and costs
- 5 Receive the confirmation screen before logging off

Timing is important!

You must enroll in a new plan 60 days before or after you lose your current coverage.



While visiting the Health Insurance Marketplace, consider Community Health Options, a Maine based, non-profit Member-led health plan.

- ▶ Free preventive care services, like annual wellness visits, flu shots, and a range of birth control medications and methods

Health Options offers plans through the Health Insurance Marketplace so you can qualify and purchase a plan in just one visit. **If your household falls within the income ranges shown, you may be eligible for Advance Premium Tax Credits that make plans more affordable.**

If you don't qualify for a Special Enrollment Period, you can enroll for January 2020 coverage from November 1 – December 15 during open enrollment.
